## **2018 COUNTY OFFICES Signature Requirements**

• Constitution and Libertarian follow new party signature counts per SDCL 12-6-7.

• (AL): denotes the 15 Counties that elect Commissioners At Large. (AL) Counties follow the signature requirement numbers below.

• Call AUDITOR: These counties elect Commissioners by district. The County Auditor will have to calculate the signature requirements for those Commissioner races that have no number listed below. All other county offices would follow the numbers below.

• Republican and Democratic: 50 signatures or 1% of the vote for their party's Gubernatorial candidate in the county in the 2014 election, whichever is less (SDCL 12-6-7.1)

• Independent: signatures equal to 1% of the total vote for Governor in 2014 in their county (SDCL 12-7-1)

• (VC): Vote Center County (see bottom of page for signature calculation explanation)

## SIGNATURE CALCULATION EXPLANATION FOR VOTE CENTER COUNTIES:

• If a county uses Vote Centers, below is how they calculate signature requirements per SDCL 12-6-7:

... If a county uses vote centers and does not print ballots by precinct, signature requirements for both partisan and independent candidates are:

(1) Fifty signatures for a legislative candidate whose district either in whole or in part includes that county;

(2) Thirty signatures for a county candidate;

(3) Fifteen signatures for county commissioner district candidates;

(4) Five signatures for a new party legislative candidate whose district either in whole or in part includes that county;

(5) Five signatures for a new party county candidate; or

(6) Three signatures for a new party county commissioner district candidate
